A) Revise Board Policy 6.312, Use of Personal Communication Devices in School, **second reading**. On May 7, 2007, this revision was referred to the May 17th work session. On June 4, 2007 the revision submitted by the middle and high school principals was tabled until the July 2nd Board meeting.

B) Revise on **second reading** Board Policy 6.205, Student Assignment. On July 2, 2007 this revision passed on first reading.

Page 2, item 7 – under Resident students/verification of residence shall read:

Students whose parent or legal guardian is a certificated employee of the Cheatham County School System may attend a school other than their assigned school.

Page 3, item b-1 – under Procedure – the last sentence shall read:

Examples of situations where “in loco parentis” authority of an adult should be recognized to establish residency of the minor include, but are not limited to, the following:

A) Revise on **first reading** Board Policy 6.319, Alternative School Programs. The second sentence of the first paragraph shall read: *Attendance in alternative school programs shall be mandatory and students attending an alternative school will ride a bus to and from the alternative school (exceptions may be made by the Director of Schools).*

B) Revise on **first reading** Board Policy 1.403, Agendas. Paragraph five shall read:

C) Revise on **second reading** Board Policy 6.200, Attendance. Board Policy #1.600, Policy Development and Adoption, reads in part: The

Board's approval of the proposal or return for study and/or further revision shall constitute the first reading." This was accomplished during the July 19th and July 24th work session. Some changes under Making Up Time for Grades 9-12 are as follows:

Add as item 5 and change the following numbering sequence:

5. *Time-for-Time must be made up within ten (10) school days following the absence.*

Third sentence of item 7 shall read:

Appeals sent to the appeal committee must be submitted in writing within ten (10) days following the absence, with appropriate documentation attached.

Item 7, **delete** the last two sentences as follows:

Parents are urged to make their appeals as quickly as possible after the absences occur. The deadline for making appeals is no later than 30 calendar days after the parents receive the grades at the conclusion of any semester.

Delete paragraph 9 as follows:

Students who achieve perfect attendance for a given course within a given quarter or semester shall have three points added to their semester grade for that course for that quarter or semester. Students who are absent from a given course for no more than three times within a given quarter or semester, whether the absences are excused or unexcused, may have the three points added to their quarter or semester grade by attending time make-up sessions on a voluntary basis for as many as three times for that given course within that given quarter or semester.

D) Approval of the Mass Care Shelter Agreement with the Nashville Area Chapter, American Red Cross. This agreement would allow the Red Cross to use the Board's buildings, grounds, and equipment for mass care shelters required to conduct Red Cross Disaster Services activities.

E) Harpeth High School requests permission to add a 40X40 foot room (for wrestling) to the existing field house located on the HMS campus (at the 170 Harpeth View Trail address). Funds for the addition will be raised by HHS and generous donations.

F) Employment – Director of Schools – Contract Approval - The items modified per the July 19th workshop were incorporated and referred to legal counsel by the chairman. Mr. Wheeler indicated that all provisions meet statutory and legal requirements. He saw no discrepancies and indicated the Board could proceed.

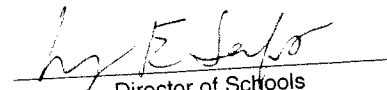
