

Dear Cheatham County Central High School parents,

The State Report Card has been released and I want to share the good news with our community, because we are very proud of our teachers and students. Here are some of the highlights:

- On six of the seven Gateway and End-of-Course tests, our students scored above their predicted scores! Four of those six are significantly “Above” and the other two are considered “NDD,” which means they were right at their predicted growth.
- Our students at CCCHS scored an average of 5 points higher on the Algebra Gateway than the previous year. Their scores were also 6 points higher than the Tennessee state average.
- The 11<sup>th</sup> grade TCAP Writing Assessments earned an A!
- Our Graduation rate was 91.7%.

Areas of concern include:

- Scores on the Math Foundations End-of-Course exam slipped below predictions.
- ACT Composite Scores fell from the previous year.
- 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade English scores need to improve to “Above” status from “No Determinable Difference.”

We’ve already begun plans for improvement in these areas.
