Kingston Springs Elementary School is proud to release the school results from the 2008 Tennessee Department of Education Report Card. With a teaching staff of 100% Highly Qualified Teachers, K.S.E.S. continues to be in Good Standing according to the Adequate Yearly Progress defined by the No Child Left Behind Act. In the subjects of Math and Reading, 99% of the students scored an Advanced or Proficient score on the Tennessee Comprehensive Assessment Program (TCAP). KSES students also had a 96.1% attendance rate which is 3% higher than the 2008 goal set by the state of Tennessee. Additionally, the school scored A's in the subjects of Reading/Language, Math, Science, and Social Studies, according to the TCAP Criterion Referenced (CRT) Academic Achievement and Academic Growth scoring (Value Added).
